## German Government finances the emergency repair of 30 houses in Lika and Northern Dalmatia

In the Republic of Croatia, the Office of the Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund for South Eastern Europe (ASB SEE) continues to implement the projects funded by the German Foreign Ministry under the auspices of the Stability Pact for South Eastern Europe. Therefore, the Office of ASB in Croatia is now implementing the emergency repair of 30 houses cat. 1-3 in the municipalities of Zadar and Šibenik, Lika and Northern Dalmatia, along with related sustainable measures. By repair of these houses, ASB will enable 30 Serbian families to return to their pre-war-homes and assist them in improving their income situation through sustainable measures. The reconstruction works will be completed by January 2006. The total value of this project amounts to € 211,000.

The completion of this project brings the total number of repaired housing units funded by the German Foreign Ministry and implemented by ASB in the Lika and Northern Dalmatia up to 495.

Since 1991, ASB has been providing assistance to sustainable return of refugees and displaced persons (DPs) in the targeted municipalities in Croatia through reconstruction of houses, mine-clearance, technical and social infrastructure and provision of humanitarian aid with funds of the German Government. Until now, ASB has implemented projects funded by the German Government for a total value of € 7 million and reconstructed more than 894 houses.

The Stability Pact is based on key experiences and lessons from worldwide international crisis management. Conflict prevention and peace building can be successful only if they start in parallel in three key sectors: the creation of a secure environment, the promotion of sustainable democratic systems, and the promotion of economic and social well-being. Only if there is progress in all three sectors can a self-sustaining process of peace be achieved. In the founding document, more than 40 partner countries and organisations undertook to strengthen the countries of South Eastern Europe "in their efforts to foster peace, democracy, respect for human rights and economic prosperity in order to achieve stability in the whole region". Euro-Atlantic integration was promised to all the countries in the region.
