**The European Commission and its implementing partner  
“Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund” (ASB) completed reconstruction of  
kindergarten “Bubamara” in Benkovac**

One of the priorities of the EU reconstruction programme in the Republic of Croatia, apart from the housing projects, is the repair of the supporting infrastructure since it is necessary to provide conditions for sustainable reintegration by meeting the future needs of the population and to facilitate economic revitalisation.

The Office of the Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund (ASB) was requested to assist with enhancing of learning and working conditions for the pre-school children and teachers using the kindergarten facility. Through funding from the European Commission, ASB performed works valued at € 13,500 which included rehabilitation of the electricity and replacement of windows. There are currently 40 children and teachers using this kindergarten “Bubamara” that now have adequate facilities for the educational development of the pre-school children. The project will also create possibilities for enrolment of more children in the future.

The reconstruction of a kindergarten in the municipality of Benkovac, financed by the European Union and implemented by ASB (ASB) is another integral step in the ongoing European Union Reconstruction Programme for Return (Europska Unija Program Obnove za Povratak - EUPOP).
