## ASB deliveries 39 hospital beds to medical institutions in Belgrade

The German humanitarian organisation Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund e.V. (ASB) has finalised the delivery of 39 hospital beds to three medical institutions in Belgrade. The donation was arranged through a close co-operation with ASB's Branch Office in Worms (Germany), which organised the collection and transport of the beds from Germany to Serbia.

The selection of beneficiary institutions for this donation has been done after a series of meetings with a number of health institutions in Belgrade. The majority of the hospitals and health clinics in Belgrade as well as in other parts of Serbia are in high need of support regarding repairs and equipment. The institutions included into this donation are the Univerzitetska Decja Klinika Belgrade (15 pcs.), the Klinicki-bolnicki Centar Zemun (15 pcs.) and the Klinicko-bolnicki Centar Bezanijska Kosa Zemun (9 pcs.).

The donation is part of ASB's continuing efforts to provide relief, rehabilitation and development for Serbia's deprived population. Since its inception in 2000, ASB has implemented a variety of projects ranging from humanitarian aid and relief to sustainability and development. Currently, ASB is finalising the construction of 24 apartments in Leskovac, which will be used to provide a sustainable housing solution for 22 refugee families and two local vulnerable families. The project is implemented through a close cooperation with the Serbian Commissariat for Refugees and the Municipality of Leskovac. In all, ASB Serbia has implemented projects with a total value of over € 5,5 million throughout the entire republic.
